

January 26, 2022 MAA Meeting Minutes

Attendance: Mike Broadbent, Dana Cyr, Val Marquez, Spencer Ives, Heather Stanley, Rick Hebert

The agenda was 1. Awards, 2. Voting, 3. Sending letters, 4. Raffles

Awards: The officers voted to buy belt buckles for SOY winners. Dana will order those and has someone ready to engrave them. It will cost roughly \$75 for engraving. Dana will order 10 more buckles to cover unexpected. It was approved. Mike gave final counts for potential SOY winners and state championship winners: 31 people who qualify for SOY. Potentially, 31 first place, 13 second place, and 8 third place people for state shoot awards. The officers voted to order 61 state shoot awards which gives 3 extra per place to cover anything unexpected. The price would be roughly \$350. It was approved. The officers voted to offer for raffles two people could win their membership reimbursement and 2 people could win to have 4 shoots reimbursed. The state patch has been ordered. Steve, Lakeside, offered to pay for those patches as a donation. T-shirts for this year quoted at \$8 cost per shirt. Price of sale will be determined later and any profits from those sales will go towards the scholarship fund.

Letters: Val updated everyone with places that he has sent letters out to. He has sent to Matthews, PSE, Easton, and some regular archery shops to try to obtain donations. It was suggested to send letters to some local restaurants and places such as Bruce's Burritos, Two-Dine In, Clayton's, Brickyard Hollow, Louis' Grille, Five Guys, Aroma Joes, Starbuck's, and Dunkin' Donuts. Dana has a list of other possible choices and would send that list to Val.

Raffles: Will get the raffle items and basket to Mike a week before the scholarship shoot. The scholarship shoot is happening March 20th. The state shoot will happen March 25-27th. Raffles will be at both shoots.

Voting: The officers voted to have this year's voting for officer positions to be a paper ballot. They can mail their vote in or bring it to the state shoot. Tallies will be done by Val at the state shoot. Two positions are up for election: Treasurer and President. At this time Spencer Ives and Mike Broadbent are running for President. Heather Stanley is running for Treasurer. It will be on the facebook and website for any others who wish to run for either position to contact an officer to have their name on the ballot by Feb. 28th. Ballots will be sent out via email and on the website by March 1st.
