- Applicant is required to be a current MAA member
- Applicant needs to be a current graduating senior in high school or a current enrolled college or trade school student working towards a degree under the age of 25. Former scholarship award winners are not eligible for additional awards.
- Include one (1) Letter of Recommendation (non-family member) with application
